a.

must be female player born in 1996 or 1997 which is required by IIHF (NO OTHER AGES WILL BE ACCEPTED)

b.

must have great desire to play game fairly and demonstrate sportsmanship both on and off the ice;

c.

must be a good ambassador for ice hockey for Hong Kong

d.

must have positive and enthusiastic attitude and respect to teammates, coaches, game officials and administrators.

e.

must be a good role model to support the development of ice hockey

2. Learn To play Instructor Seminar:

a.

must be able to speak and understand English

b.

must be currently active within an HKIHA / HKIHA Registered Club's league and/ or within the national Association;

c.

must be good role model for other coaches and demonstrate Fair Play and Respect and good leadership skills.

d. must be able to contribute back to Hong Kong Ice Hockey

e. must have great desire to learn and teach Ice Hockey

Carrying on from work that was done during the Women's Leadership Seminars during the 2008 and 2010 HDC's this year sees the program move into practical programming with the National Association Women's Learn to Play Seminar. The seminar will cover most of the usual program used during past Learn to Play Instructors seminars, but it will also feature many other aspects of entry level development.

2. Team Manager –

- Ø must be able to speak and understand English;
- Ø must have experience in working in a team management setting;
- Ø must posses good organizational abilities;
- Ø must be a good role model and have good leadership skills; demonstrate Fair Play and Respect and have credibility in team management.

3. Team Equipment Manager –

- Ø must be able to speak and understand English;
- Ø should be experienced in team equipment management functions;
- Ø must have experience in working in a team setting;
- Ø must possess good organizational abilities;
- Ø must have good leadership skills and be good role model.

4. Game Official (Female only) –

- Ø must be able to speak and understand English;
- Ø must be in good physical condition;
- Ø must possess good skating skills;
- Ø must have good physical appearance and presence with good self confidence;
- Ø motivation to develop herself as a game official

5. Goalkeeper Coach –

- Ø must be able to speak and understand English;
- Ø minimum requirement – HKIHA Level 1 Coach which is required by IIHF;
- Ø must be currently active within HKIHA/ HKIHA Registered Club's league and/ or within the national Association as a Goalkeeper Coach;
- Ø must be a good role model;
- Ø must demonstrate good leadership skills.
